

BSGE Annual Scientific Meeting 18^{th -} 19th May 2017 Hull "WHERE ARE WE NOW AND WHERE ARE WE GOING ..."

We are delighted to announce that the BSGE Annual Scientific Meeting 2017 will be held at the <u>City Hall</u>, in Hull on Thursday 18th& Friday 19th May 2017. Pre-congress Masterclasses will run on Wednesday, 17th May at the Clinical Skills Building, <u>Hull Royal Infirmary</u>, Hull.

Following on from the success of the Cornwall 2016 ASM, our membership has continued to grow and now exceeds 1000. The theme of this Annual Scientific Meeting is how do we make the minimal access approach the standard for all benign gynaecology. We have already had significant interest from our members about the meeting and some applications from industry partners keen to participate in the forthcoming ASM. This announcement is to give your company the opportunity to take part.

Sessions at the ASM will be themed and will involve expert invited speakers presenting and discussing the latest developments. These will include topics such as making the UK the leader in laparoscopic hysterectomy, which will look in depth at the UK training programme for laparoscopic hysterectomy developed by the BSGE.

As you would expect, the live sessions, formal presentations, video sessions and breakout meetings will cover our usual topics of advanced laparoscopic surgery for endometriosis, hysteroscopic surgery, fibroids and heavy menstrual bleeding, as well urogynaecology, the pelvic floor, fertility, ultrasound, and gynaecological oncology. This meeting will enable industry to introduce technical advances and new products to delegates.

There will be poster presentations along with the industry stands in a specially designed area which will include the main catering for the meeting, so delegates will be readily available to visit industry stands.

The pre-congress masterclasses on the 17th May will be held in the state of the art Clinical Skills Building at Hull Royal Infirmary and will look at the use of simulation in developing the laparoscopist and hysteroscopist, as well as hands on Hysteroscopy training.

Hull Maritime Museum & City Hall

Hull City Hall is right in the city centre of Hull in Queen Victoria Square. It is near the Maritime Museum and Ferens Art Gallery.

The city architect, J H Hirst, designed the City Hall, mainly in the renaissance style of the Wren Period.

The building is constructed of fair faced Ashlar stone and extends to a height of three stories.

On the long North and South sides, entrances to the main hall and gallery interrupt the ground storey shops at intervals.

The main entrance facing Queen Victoria Square to the eastern side has an elegant central Tuscan porch which projects over the pavement. Above this, extending through both storeys, is a recessed ornamental panel, (known as a cartouche). Aloft of this in the area between the door lintel and the arch above (called the tympanum) bear the arms of Kingston Upon Hull. Situated above the semi-circular low pitched gable rises a glorious crowning dome made of copper, which is partly based on the arcaded design of the drum on that of St. Paul's Cathedral in London.

The dome is gracefully seated upon glazed reedings between rectangular columns. These project slightly from the wall (called lonic pilasters) and have four projecting canopied recesses. In the foreground of each recess there is a magnificent carved image (known a pedimented tabernacles) set diagonally to the axis of the building.

The Hull City Hall now holds numerous and varied events ranging from the Classics Orchestral Concert series to pop concerts, comedy, conferences, exhibitions and degree ceremonies.
